

Items Provided:

Dormitory rooms are single occupancy with a bed, full dresser, a desk with lighting, bookshelves, and a closet for each student. Twin and extra-long twin mattresses are available.

- Items Needed:
- Bedding: mattress pad, pillows, sheets, blanket, comforter
- Towels and washcloths
- Toiletries: deodorant, shampoo, soap, toothbrush, toothpaste, shower caddy, Kleenex
- Laundry supplies: basket, detergent, fabric softener, quarters: \$0.75 to wash & \$0.75 to dry
- School supplies: notebooks, 3-ring binder, notebook paper, pens, pencils, erasers, highlighters, backpack, calculator, etc.
- Basic desk/health supplies: tape, stapler, flash drive, Band-Aids, etc.
- Electrical power strip and/or extension cords
- Umbrella or rain jacket or poncho
- Wall decorations: must follow Residence Hall Handbook guidelines listed for Room Décor.
- Clothes: (must follow Dress Code guidelines in Student Handbook). Please bring winter wear when you come in August as Minnesota weather may turn cold early

Optional Items:

- Computer, Cell Phone, Kindle, Nook, etc.
- Chargers for electronics
- Floor rugs (wall-to-wall carpet is not permitted)
- Fan (Air Conditioners are in each room while the weather is hot.)
- Iron, small ironing board
- Athletic equipment (sport specific athletic shoes, shin guards, baseball/softball glove, knee pads, balls, etc.)
- Dorm sized refrigerator (not to exceed 2.0 cubic feet. Limit 1 per room.)
- Snacks, sealed container for snacks
- Plate, cup, bowl, utensils, etc. for snacks
- Coffee pot

Do NOT Bring the Following:

- Hotplates, hot pots, rice cookers, toasters, microwaves, toaster ovens
- Electric blankets, space heaters
- Pets
- Fireworks
- Street or traffic signs
- Sunlamps
- Couch, futon
- Barbells, weights, pull-up bar

- Candles, incense
- Alcohol, tobacco, drugs
- Anything promoting sex, violence, racist organizations, bad language, etc. (posters, clothing, etc.)
